

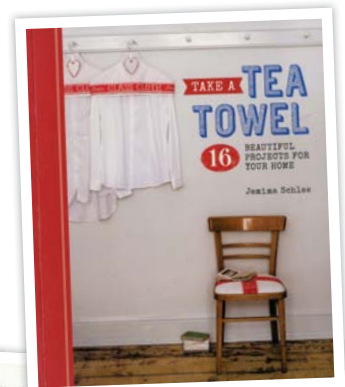
TAKE A TEA TOWEL
